

**SUMMARY RECORD OF DISCUSSIONS OF THE 4<sup>TH</sup> MEETING OF GODAVARI  
RIVER MANAGEMENT BOARD HELD ON 16<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER, 2016.**

The 4<sup>th</sup> meeting of Godavari River Management Board (GRMB) was held under the Chairmanship of Shri Ram Saran, Chairman, GRMB at Jalasoudha, Hyderabad on 16<sup>th</sup> November, 2016.

At the outset, the Chairman welcomed the Members, and other participants from Government of Andhra Pradesh (GoAP) and Government of Telangana (GoTS).

He termed the meeting as momentous because many decisions of previous meeting have been implemented. He thanked the Members of both State Govts in particular the representatives of GoTS for having provided permanent office space and budgetary fund into the Board's Bank Account. He commended the efforts of Members and officers of both the State Govts for their contribution towards the progression of the Board.

He emphasised that the Board needs to gather further momentum in certain aspects like notification of the projects for bringing them under Jurisdiction of the Board, website development, data collection from all the projects of Godavari river basin in both the States, finalization of Working Manual of the Board and finalization of deputation of officers and staff from Government of India as well as from both the State Governments. He also urged the Members of the Board and all the concerned officers to lay ardent focus on these issues. Reposing confidence that both the State Govts would provide utmost support to the Board in achieving the above targets, he requested Member Secretary to take up the Agenda items for discussion.

Accordingly, Member Secretary initiated discussions on the Agenda items.

The list of participants in the meeting is at **Annexure –I**.

**Item No. 4.1 Confirmation of Summary Record of discussions of 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting of Godavari River Management Board held on 21.01.2016.**

The draft Summary Record of Discussions of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Board meeting was circulated to both the State Governments by e-mail on 25.01.2016 and after receiving the views/comments the same was duly modified and communicated to all Members on 03.02.2016. GoAP further conveyed some more observations vide their letter dated 09.03.2016 proposing some modifications in summery record, which was replied on 29.03.2016. GoAP in their letter had suggested to include the following sentence at the end of item No. 3.5 at page No. 4 of the minutes of 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting:

*“As far as new projects are concerned, both States must submit DPRs and also comply with the mandate of A.P Reorganisation Act, 2014 with regard to new projects.”*

GoTS disagreed on inclusion of the above view in SRD. They furnished their opinion in writing which has been communicated to GoAP for the response. GoAP informed that they would respond within one week, which is awaited. Except the above, all other items of SRD of 3<sup>rd</sup> Board meeting are confirmed by the Board.

## **Item No. 4.2 Administrative and Financial Matters of the Board**

### ***4.2.1 Funds position of GRMB***

For the F.Y 2015-16 a budget of Rs. 7 crore was sanctioned by GoTS and Rs.1.75 crore was released for the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter vide G.O. Rt. No. 1634 Finance (EBS.IX) Department dated 24.04.2015. The details of expenditure during the FY 2015-16 of Rs 99.63 lakhs and expenditure of Rs. 64.53 lakhs (excluding expenditure towards infrastructure development of new office space for GRMB) upto 18.10.2016 of FY 2016-17 were placed before the Board for approval vide **Annexure-II** and **Annexure-III**. The Board approved the same.

Revised Estimate of Rs. 2.175 crore for the FY 2016-17 (excluding expenditure towards infrastructure development for new office space) and Budget Estimate of Rs 6.50 crore for the FY 2017-18 were communicated to Engineers-in-Chief of both the State Governments in November, 2016 for further action at their end. The same are exhibited under **Annexure-IV**. The Board approved the Revised Estimate and the Budget Estimate.

### ***4.2.2 Authorization to use the Budget directly by the Board***

Board Members were informed that the Board's Current Account No. 35185323861 of SBI, Khairatabad Branch, Hyderabad has been approved by GoTS vide their letters dated 23.09.2016 & 03.10.2016 for transferring budgetary funds to the Board. GoTS deposited an amount of Rs. 83,45,079 on 19.10.2016 into the Board's Current Account towards expenditure for the balance period of FY 2016-17.

### ***4.2.3 Vehicles***

Member Secretary informed that hired vehicles have been discontinued in anticipation of new vehicles to be supplied by GoTS in accordance with their G.O. Ms. No. 60 dated 29.08.2016 in which ENC(I) was given administrative approval for an amount

of Rs. 52.24 lakhs to purchase 5 vehicles for GRMB. An amount of Rs. 52.24 lakhs from budgetary fund of GRMB earmarked for purchase of new vehicles has been kept with GoTS. Due to slight increase in the cost of certain vehicles, revised administrative approval was sought by ENC(I). However, keeping in view the possible delay in obtaining revised administrative approval, Member (A), GoTS suggested that the difference of cost can be paid by the Board instead of awaiting revised approval. The suggestion was agreed upon by the Board. Accordingly, the Board Secretariat will provide the extra cost involved in procurement of new vehicles to GoTS on demand.

### **Item No. 4.3 Office accommodation & Infrastructure for the Board**

It was informed to the Board Members that in pursuance of GoTS letter dated 05.10.2016 Board secretariat occupied the new office space at 5<sup>th</sup> floor of Jalasoudha on 19.10.2016 duly handing over the temporary office space hitherto used at 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of Jalasoudha to GoTS vide letter dated 31.10.2016. Member Secretary expressed that two side screens and one screen at the back of the Chair need to be additionally provided in Conference Hall, as the Hall is provided with only one screen which is not sufficient.

### **Item No. 4.4 Human Resources**

#### ***4.4.1 Deputation of officers/ staff from CWC***

Member Secretary informed that GRMB requires permanent and stable work force to assist the Board in resolving various issues relating to water management and water regulation and that the domain knowledge professionals are required from Central Water Commission (CWC). Presently, Chairman post and 3 Chief Engineer Posts from Central Govt. are only permanent posts among which 2 Chief Engineer posts are vacant. All other officers/ staffs working in GRMB are on OD or additional charge basis. To avoid this instability, it was proposed to deploy the officers from CWC as given in the table below:

The matter was discussed and deferred.

#### **4.4.2 Deputation of officers/ staff from State Governments**

Member Secretary proposed that the existing officers / staff, who have been deployed by both the State Governments on OD basis, shall be placed at the disposal of the Board on deputation basis to carry out the mandated tasks effectively and requested State Govts. to create the following posts urgently for those who are working in GRMB on OD basis and communicate the Government Order for continuing their services on deputation basis:

Member Secretary further informed that the Board Secretariat has already communicated the matter to both the State Governments vide its letter dated 02.11.2016. The issue was deliberated by the Board and it was decided to finalise the matter at appropriate stage. Till then the existing arrangement may be continued.

#### **4.4.3 Deputation of Accounts/ Audit Officer from Central Accounting Services**

It was informed that one Accounts Officer from GoTS was posted to GRMB on additional charge whose services were withdrawn due to her transfer outside I & CAD Dept. Recently Budgetary fund has been deposited into Board's Bank Account and the Board Secretariat has to manage the fund independently as per GoI norms. Hence, Member Secretary proposed that an Accounts/ Audit Officer from Central Accounting Services like Accountant General (AG) office may be deployed on deputation basis to handle financial aspects of the Board. The method of recruitment on deputation to GRMB is given in **Annexure-V**. Selection Committee comprising Member Secretary and ENC's from both the State Govts. will finalise the selection process with the approval of Chairman.

The Board agreed for deployment of Accounts / Audit Officer on deputation basis.

#### **Item No. 4.5 Finalization of Draft Working Manual for the Board**

The draft Working Manual was communicated to both the State Governments in September, 2014 seeking their views/ comments. Subsequently modified draft Working Manual was communicated to them in December, 2015 duly incorporating their views. The matter was included in the last Board meeting under item no. 3.4. However, the item was deferred as Members from both the States needed time to finalize the same. In the mean time, the final draft was once again communicated to both the States on 01.03.2016 for their consideration. No comments have been received from GoAP. GoTS responded in their letter dated 26.05.2016 stating that the responsibilities, duties and powers of Chairman given in Annex-III of Working Manual are inconsistent with the provision of the Act. However, GoTS have not provided the clarity regarding “inconsistency” raised by them. Both the States were once again requested to submit their views by 11.11.2016 vide this office letter dated 31.10.2016. Response is awaited.

Member Secretary pointed out that the working manual evidently is a pivotal document in which the role of the Board in accordance with the AP Reorganisation Act, 2014 is enumerated and emphasised that the approval of the manual has not happened for over two years. He appealed to the Members to approve the Working Manual at the earliest so that the Board is enabled to discharge its functions enshrined in the Act effectively.

During discussion, the Members opined that the matter needs further examination and decided to convene a special meeting in the month of December, 2016 to finalise and approve the Working Manual.

#### **Item No. 4.6 Authenticated data of projects**

Member Secretary stated that to carry out water accounting, water use, availability, regulation, monitoring etc. as envisaged in the Act, authenticated live data is essential. The Board had already requested both the State Governments to furnish authenticated data of all major/ medium projects located in Godavari Basin in respective States. GoTS has furnished water level, inflow/ outflow and storage capacity of 3 Nos. of major projects and 1 No. medium project for water year 2015-16; and current year data for 2 Nos. of major projects and 1 No. medium project. GoAP has not furnished any data of water year 2015-16 and 2016-17 as well. GoAP agreed to provide the relevant data in 15 days. The data for all major/ medium projects need to be provided by both the States for compilation in a time bound manner for effective monitoring of water utilization.

The website of GRMB (phase-I) is in the process of auditing/ hosting in NIC, Delhi and will be launched shortly. The requisite data are to be loaded directly by project personnel on daily basis. The nodal officer along with field officer for each project may be identified so that they can directly upload the daily data. Each person will be provided with the login details. The contact numbers of such nodal/ field officers may be provided to Board Secretariat.

#### **Item No. 4.7 New proposals in Godavari Basin by GoT/ GoAP**

Member Secretary intimated that DPRs of new proposals in the basin may be submitted by respective State Governments to the Board for appraisal as per the provision of AP Reorganisation Act, 2014. The same was agreed to.

#### **Item No. 4.8 Projects for notification for bringing them under jurisdiction of the Board**

Member Secretary stated that as per Sections 85(1) and 87(1) of the AP Reorganization Act, 2014, projects in Godavari Basin in Telangana and Andhra Pradesh States are required to be notified for bringing them under the jurisdiction of the Board. Accordingly, the Board has requested both the State Governments to communicate the list of such projects. GoAP has provided the list in the month of December, 2015, however GoTS has not furnished any such list. He further informed that MoWR is insisting the Board to submit the list of projects for notification. Accordingly, a draft notification has been prepared and communicated on 31.10.2016 to both the States for their views. Their views are awaited. The draft notification is exhibited at **Annexure-VI**.

Member (A), GoAP informed that they would furnish their views on this issue in 15 days time.

Member (A), GoTS informed that they had already conveyed their opinion vide Memo No. 311/IS.EA.1/2014 dated 07.11.2015 addressed to ENC (I), GoTS and copied to Member Secretary, GRMB. The excerpts from the memo are reproduced hereunder:

“As per Section 87 of the Act the intention behind the notification of the Projects by the Central Government is to deliver the water to the successor States through these Projects having regard to the Awards made under ISWD Act, 1956. In the instant case neither any specific project wise allocation has been made to any of the Projects in the State nor any enbloc allocation is made to the State by any Tribunal. Whatever allocations made to the Projects now are by means of various Government Orders issued by erstwhile A.P. Government”.

However, it was decided by the Chairman that the draft notification for jurisdiction along with the views of State Governments, if received any, will be sent to Ministry in December, 2016 for further appropriate action.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks.

## METHOD OF RECRUITMENT ON DEPUTATION TO GRMB

Subject to the candidate having minimum qualification and experience as specified in the Schedules, candidates from other Central Government, State Government, Ministries/ Departments, Semi-Govt. organizations, Universities, Research Institutions, Autonomous Bodies, Public Sector Undertakings, can be taken on deputation basis on the following terms and conditions, namely:

1. The candidate holding the post analogous to the post applied for in terms of Pay scale and status;

Provided that:-

- a) The period of deputation shall be initially for three years, which can be extended up to a maximum period of five years only after obtaining the written consent of the incumbent and lending organization. The period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/department shall not exceed 5 years.
  - b) Candidate appointed on deputation and having promoted in the parent cadre shall be considered for such promotion in the Board subjected to availability of such post.
1. Period of Deputation: The tenure of deputation will be for a period of 3 years initially which can be extended up to 5 years.
  2. Pay: During the period of deputation, the pay of the officer will be regulated in terms of the pay of parent cadre post only.
  3. Deputation allowance: In addition to the pay of their parent cadre post, the officer shall be entitled to draw deputation (duty) allowance as admissible in terms of the prevailing Government of India norms.
  4. Dearness allowance: The officer will be entitled to Dearness allowance as per the Central/State Government Rules to the respective officials.
  5. House Rent allowance:
    - i) If the officer retains Government Accommodation with the approval of the Government, he would be required to pay for the Government Accommodation as per the rates prescribed by the Government; or
    - ii) If the officer does not retain or does not have Government Accommodation; he would draw HRA at the rates regulated in terms of rules of the lending authority.
  6. Transfer Travelling Allowance, Joining Time and Joining Time Pay: The deputationist will be entitled to TA and joining time both on joining the post on deputation and on reversion as per GRMB/ Government of India rules and expenditure on this account will be borne by the GRMB.

7. TA/DA for journey on duty: The deputationist will be paid Travelling Allowance and Daily Allowance in connection with the official work under GRMB whether in India or abroad, as per relevant provision of Government of India.
8. Medical Facilities: The GRMB shall offer to the deputationist medical facilities in accordance with rules of lending organization. The deputationist can avail medical facilities in any referral hospital recognized by either of the State Governments of A.P and Telangana or GoI.
9. Leave/ LTC: During the period of deputation, the officer will continue to be governed by the Rules applicable to him/ her as per parent department/ Government in respect of Leave (except casual leave which shall be as per GoI Rules)/ Leave Travel concession and expenditure on account of LTC will be borne by the borrowing organization.
10. Provident Fund: During the period of deputation the officer will continue to subscribe to the Provident Fund he was subscribing at the time of proceeding on deputation and will continue to be governed by the rules of such fund. The borrowing organization will deduct the amount to be deposited in the General Provident Fund Account of the officer on deputation from his salary drawn by the officer each month and will remit the said amount to the concerned authority of State/ Central Govt. from time to time.
11. Conduct, Discipline and Appeal Rules: The deputationist shall continue to be governed by service and conduct Rules of the parent department.
12. Disability Leave: GRMB will be liable to pay leave emoluments in respect of disability incurred in and through Foreign Service even though such disability manifests itself after termination of the Foreign Service. The rules of parent department shall be applicable in such cases.
13. Leave Salary/ Pension Contribution: The borrowing organization shall pay leave salary and pension contribution to the concerned authority of State/ Central Govt during deputation at the rate in force from time to time in accordance with the orders issued by respective State Government/ Government of India. These contributions shall be paid within fifteen days from end of each month for which the pay has been drawn by the Government servant. If the contributions are not paid within the stipulated time period, the borrowing organization shall be liable to pay interest on the unpaid contributions at such rates as fixed by the respective Government from time to time.
14. Group Insurance: During the period of deputation the officer will continue to be governed by the Central Government Employees Group Insurance Scheme, 1980/ Group Insurance Scheme of respective State and the deduction towards GIS shall be made by GRMB at the rate prevailing in respective parent department.
15. Residential Accommodation/ Conveyance/ Other Facilities/ Allowance: The officer will be entitled to Residential Accommodation/ Conveyance Allowance/ office vehicle/ other facilities as admissible under the rules of borrowing organization.

16. Residuary Matters: In all matters relating to conditions of service and benefits/ facilities and perquisites in the borrowing organization not covered by items 1 to 15 above, the deputationist shall be governed by the existing rules, regulations and orders of borrowing organization.

The above mentioned terms and conditions would be applicable till the deputationist remains on deputation with GRMB. On reversion from deputation, he will be governed by the relevant rules laid down by parent department.

17. Selection Process: The lending department will send all the applications to the GRMB. The selection of the suitable candidate shall be decided by the selection committee constituted by Member Secretary in consultation with Chairperson and its decision shall be final.

DRAFT NOTIFICATION FOR BRINGING PROJECTS UNDER JURISDICTION OF  
GODAVARI RIVER MANAGEMENT BOARD

- 1 (1) In exercise of the powers conferred by the section 85 of Andhra Pradesh Reorganization Act, 2014 (No.6 of 2014), the Central Government by its notification dated 28th May 2014 constituted Godavari River Management Board (GRMB) for the administration, regulation, maintenance and operation of such projects on Godavari River, as may be notified by the Central Government from time to time.
- (2) In exercise of powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 87 of Andhra Pradesh Reorganization Act, 2014 and based on the following broad guiding principles (which were incorporated in Regulations-2014 of GRMB under rule No. 16), the Central Government hereby notifies that till further orders, the jurisdiction of Godavari River Management Board (herein after referred as Board) shall be on projects/project components as given next below:

Guiding principles for taking over jurisdiction of Projects under GRMB:

- (i) Project(s) where water is to be regulated for various uses by both the State Governments.
- (ii) Project(s) where only power is generated and is used by both the State Governments.
- (iii) Project(s) where water is used by one State and power so generated is used by the other State.
- (iv) Project(s) where utilization of water by one State will be affecting the allocation of water to the other.
- (v) Project(s) desired by any of the two State Governments.
- (vi) All categories of projects which will not be directly under the administrative control of the Board and are being operated/maintained by the respective State Governments shall be under the purview of the Board for the purpose of monitoring and water accounting.

3 The budget and finances of the Board shall be provided by both the Government of successor States as per the sub-section (2) of section 86 of the Andhra Pradesh Reorganisation Act, 2014.

Field formation of the Board

4 (1) The staff, who immediately before the commencement of this notification, were engaged in maintenance, operation, construction of the projects and project components referred in Para 1(3) and 1(4) above shall, after such commencement be deemed to have been brought under the administrative and technical control of the Board. The services of all such staff shall be placed by the respective Governments at the disposal of the Board on deputation basis.

(2) Any special allowance to be paid to such staff shall be decided by the Board and such decision shall be communicated to the respective Governments for information. The personnel so deputed shall be governed by the rules framed by the Board from time to time.

(3) The Board shall exercise the right to deploy adequate number of personnel in each cadre in the establishments under its jurisdiction and it shall be the responsibility of the respective State Government to provide such personnel.

Responsibilities of State Governments

5 (1) For efficient and effective implementation of various provisions of Andhra Pradesh Reorganisation Act, 2014, or as may be amended from time to time, in letter and spirit, the responsibilities of the respective State Government(s) shall include and not limited to the following:

(i) Supply of all historical data, current data, operating procedures, Government decisions and all other relevant information in respect of all categories of projects existing in both the States.

(ii) All such data, information etc shall be supplied within the timelines as proposed by the Board.

(iii) The expenditure towards the running, operation, maintenance including special repairs, establishment, expenditure on security aspects and any other expenditure required from time to time for the projects under the jurisdiction of the Board shall be borne by concerned States.

(iv) All financial and other resources such as human resources and infrastructural support etc as required for the functioning of the Board shall be provided by the respective States.

(v) Implementation of all decisions of the Board in letter and spirit within the stipulated time frame.

(vi) Ensuring law and order at all times in the respective jurisdiction of the States.

(vii) As per principles laid down in Para 9 of the Eleventh Schedule of the Andhra Pradesh Reorganization Act, 2014, "in case of non-

implementation of the decisions of the Board by either of the States, the defaulting state shall bear the responsibility and shall face financial and other penalties as imposed by Central Government."

(vii) Provide suitable man power to meet the functional requirement of the Board/ project and also to replace the same as and when desired by Chairman/ Member Secretary.

Joint Responsibilities of state Governments and GRMB

- (2) The joint responsibilities of State Governments and GRMB shall include the following:
- (i) Flood monitoring, disaster management in respect of projects under jurisdiction of the Board.
  - (ii) Implementation of recommendations on dam safety aspects.
  - (iii) Preparation of operating manual

Responsibilities of GRMB

- (3) The Board shall, in relation to the technical sanction, administrative approval and other sanctions required for operation and maintenance of projects under GRMB and in relation to any other administrative matters concerning the projects, exercise the powers of the Central Government.

For the purpose of regulation of supply of water, till any agreements between two States or awards by tribunal are notified, the project wise allocation by erstwhile Andhra Pradesh shall be the guiding principles.

The Board shall deal with and take charge of the following matters relating to works on or connected with the projects under its jurisdiction:

- (i) The regulation of supply of water from the projects;
- (ii) The regulation of supply of power generated, in case shared by successor States;
- (iii) Maintenance of dam, reservoir, head works/ regulator, and maintenance of main canal catering to both the States, if any;
- (iv) The granting of leases for fishery activities in the reservoir as per the recommendations of concerned State Government's Fisheries Department;
- (v) Proper utilisation of land acquired for the purpose of project; and
- (vi) Administrative control and maintenance of buildings, gardens, water supply, roads and such other assets/ amenities of the project.
- (vii) Compilation of data furnished by both the State Governments.
- (viii) Analysis of water demands and its indents placed before GRMB.
- (ix) Correspondence on water releases and issue of water release orders.

Central Industrial Security Force Arrangements

- 6 As per sub-section (7) of Section 85 of Andhra Pradesh Reorganisation Act, 2014, the Board shall be assisted in the day to day management of reservoirs by the Central Industrial Security Force. Deployment of CISF is for protection of the projects.

**PREREQUISITES BEFORE PUBLISHING**

**Important Aspects to be addressed before taking over Projects**

1. The respective State Government shall furnish the following:
  - (i) Health status of projects specifically mentioning distress features, if any.
  - (ii) Latest approved Detailed Project Report (DPR).
  - (iii) Dam Safety Panel reports and Action Taken Reports (ATRs) thereof point wise.
  - (iv) Existing Disaster Management arrangements and Emergency Action Plan.
  - (v) Detailed note on disasters occurred earlier, if any.
  - (vi) Dam Break Analysis done earlier, if any.
  - (vii) Action plan for the above along with funds requirements.
2. The common project components shall be under the jurisdiction of the Board for the purpose of operation, maintenance and modernization required, if any.
3. The State Governments shall furnish the liabilities, if any, on the projects with States'/ Central/ External Aided funds. Respective State Government shall bear responsibility of all such liabilities.
4. Authorization for GRMB by the State Governments for preparation of Integrated Operation Manual and its implementation. (The operating manual so prepared shall be discussed in the Board meeting and shall be binding on both the States).
5. The immovable assets of the Projects viz., buildings, vacant lands etc shall be handed over to GRMB for safety and security aspects. The Board shall have full control on lease of properties concerning the projects.
6. Regulation of fishery rights connected with the projects shall rest with GRMB from the date of taking over of projects by the Board.
7. The staff requirements for regulation, operation and maintenance shall be prepared by the Board and the respective State Government shall abide by it. The human resource management part will be addressed in detail separately once there is an agreement on handing over of the Projects.

8. The respective State Government shall furnish/ give their commitment for providing funds annually for establishment, operation and maintenance, special aspects, special repairs etc.
9. Till any agreements between two States or awards by tribunal are notified, the project wise allocation made by erstwhile Andhra Pradesh Government shall be applicable.
10. The projects which are based on flood waters shall be governed as per the discussions and decision taken by the Board and no State shall have any claim on assured water allocation.
11. The details on water inflow, use and related data shall be made available and will also be uploaded on any mechanism as suggested by the Board.
12. The Power generation from the projects under the jurisdiction of the Board shall be governed as per the Irrigation water requirements and the priority as per the release of water for irrigation or drinking shall be used for power generation. The release of water shall be informed to the respective State for managing the power generation, scheduling, or any other aspect regarding power including commercial aspects.
13. Board shall exercise control over the quantum of water to be passed through power house for power generation. The respective State Government shall exercise control over all other aspects of power houses.
